## PRAY FOR THE STUDENTS OF CCS TO HAVE A BLESSED YEAR AS THEY GROW IN THEIR KNOWLEDGE AND LOVE FOR CHRIST.

<sup>5</sup> Now the goal of our instruction is love that comes from a pure heart, a good conscience, and a sincere faith. 1 Timothy 1:5

Hold on to the pattern of sound teaching that you have heard from me, in the faith and love that are in Christ Jesus. <sup>14</sup> Guard the good deposit through the Holy Spirit who lives in us. 2 Timothy 1:13-14
