*Sermon Overview: Jesus tells his disciples that he has to leave so the Father can send an Advocate, the Holy Spirit. This week's message focuses on seeing the amazing opportunity we have to partner with the person of the Holy Spirit. When it comes to living a missional life, the Holy Spirit is our unfair advantage. This advantage exists as we live out the simple discipleship phrase for this series, 'We, not me.'
